We have also introduced a new behaviour system within our school celebrating the positive behaviours and supporting challenging behaviours through a restorative justice approach. Mrs Chisnell is our new behaviour lead and will be contacting you all soon with further information. In the meantime, your child may be coming home with a Bronze, Silver, Gold or Headteacher award!
